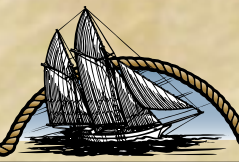

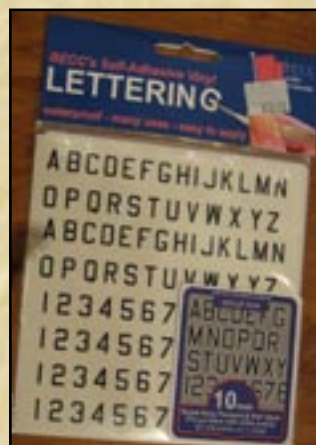


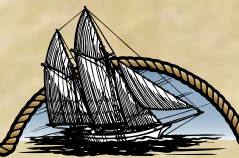
### FLAGS

Many people are delighted to know that we carry a very extensive range of flags, ranging in size from 10mm in length to 150mm. Having the correct flag on your completed model is a bit like signing your work of art - it is the final finishing touch.

We stock the BECC range of flags from England, which are high quality, double sided, cotton flags. There are National flags, Naval and Merchant Ensigns, House flags, Signal Sets and other more obscure flags. They also cover a very wide period of history so there is no excuse to have the wrong flag flown. (In some cases kit manufacturers have most inappropriate flags included in their kits) BECC also have a very good range of draught marks, plimsoll lines and other hull markings in metric and imperial and covering a wide range of scales. There are also sheets of dials and gauges, emergency signage and letters and numbers in a large range of sizes. There is also a range of Naval markings with black letters and white shadow.

It is impossible for us to keep the full range in all sizes, however, we do carry an extensive range of the more popular flags and if we do not have it we can include it in our next order. We carry the full range of lettering sizes in both black and white and a more limited range in other colours, including gold and silver.

At \$19.95 this is an absolute bargain for such a great collectable.

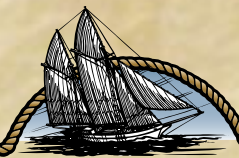
