Australian Maritime Historian Garry Kerr has produced several DVD's which will be of interest to many of you.

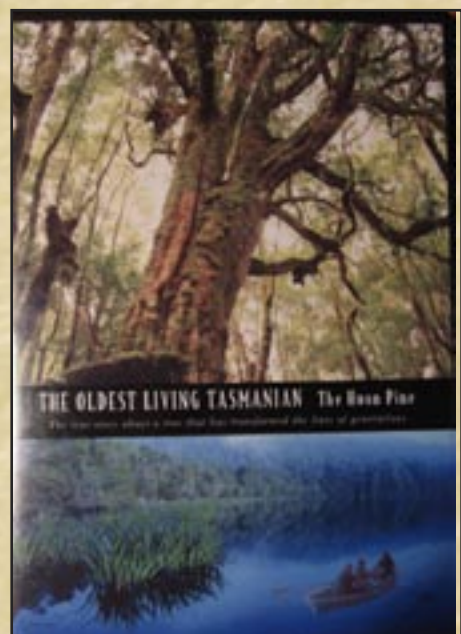
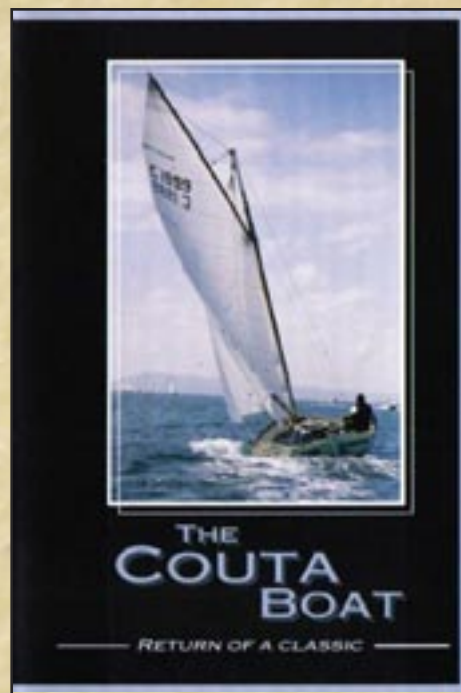

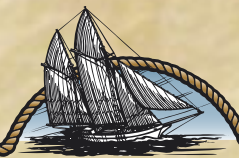
- “The ‘Couta Boat - Return of a Classic”

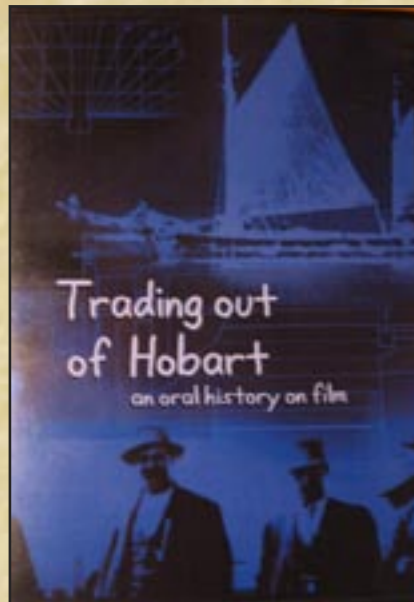

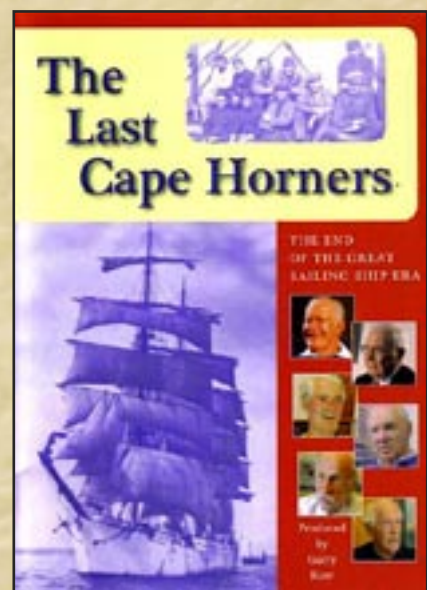

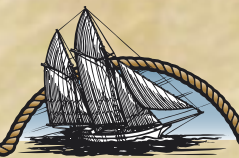

"The Last Cape Horners" covers the story of Gustaf Erikson of Finland who owned the last great fleet of square-rigged sailing ships the world would ever see. In the 1920;s, 30's & 40's they ran between South Australia and Europe via the treacherous Cape Horn carrying grain. With each captain eager to make the fastest voyage, these annual events became known as "The Grain Races"
Now old men, the Cape Horners of Australia and Finland, happily share their stories. Some speak of the romance of the sea and others shudder at the terrible conditions, but all agree it was an experience that shaped their lives and one they would not have missed for the world. 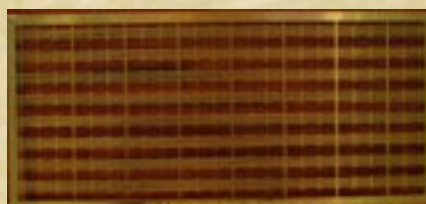
